About ACCI₂₀₂₂

As you are possibly aware, the global cancer burden is expected to be 28.4 million cases in 2040, a 47% rise from 2020, with a larger increase in transitioning (64% to 95%) versus transitioned (32% to 56%) countries due to demographic changes, although this may be further exacerbated by increasing risk factors associated with globalization and a growing economy. GLOBOCAN predicts record numbers by 2040, a true 'Cancer Epidemic' (NICPR) in the making. Efforts to build a sustainable infrastructure for the dissemination of cancer prevention measures and provision of cancer care in transitioning countries is critical for global cancer control.

4.2 million Indians are living with cancer as you read this. More than 14 lakh new cases register every year, out of which more than 8.5 lakh die of this disease. Individual financial cancer burden in India estimated at INR 36,812 at a tertiary public hospital (AIIMS) was approximately 1/10th of that at a private hospital in 2012. This figure has multiplied more than 100 fold by now. While a plethora of challenges, like Prevention and Early Detection program, inadequate and eccentrically distributed technical and human resource infrastructure stand in the way of our evolution, insufficient financial resource is perhaps the Core factor at the national, state and individual levels which limits appropriate access to standard cancer care in our country. **50% of cancer patients and their families in the country struggle financially to manage care for the disease.**
